- The scholarship will be disbursed as notification of free full HAFFE convention registration and 2 complimentary nights hotel rooms during the HAFFE convention.

Procedure

- Awarded October 15, 2024

Judging

- Applications will be delivered to the members of the scholarship selection committee
- Judging will be based on an individual score (each judge reviews each application individually and on its own merit, assigning a score to that individual application)

- Essay 40%

 - -Dedication to the fair, festival or event community
